Any firearm approved at this meeting will be published in the Maryland Register on September 20, 2024 and, barring no objections, will be included on the Maryland State Police website on October 20, 2024 as a handgun, model and caliber legal for sale in the State of Maryland.

#### **Integrated Mechanical Safety Devices**

The Board voted 7 to 1 to approve the American Outdoor Brands Product Company - Lockdown Combination Trigger Lock (SKU: 1118826); 6 to 2 to approve Lockdown Keyed Trigger Lock (SKU: 1118824); and 6 to 2 to approve Lockdown 15" Cable Gun Lock (SKU: 110149) for addition to their Approved Safety Devices list. The Maryland Handgun Roster Board approves integrated mechanical safety devices for either factory, distributor, importer aftermarket installation, or by licensed firearms retailers. Installation of any of these listed devices in an approved handgun when sold satisfies Maryland law.
